Prayer in this writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members, at the instance of the private respondents No.6 and 7, who are accused in FIR No.67 dated 22.06.2020 registered under Sections 376(2)(f), 323, 34, 506 IPC at Women Police Station Sirsa, District Sirsa and are threatening the petitioner to compromise the matter and not to pursue the case.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that till date, no arrest has been made and the police officials are openly favouring the accused persons. It is further submitted that the petitioner has given a details representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa for providing protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members and for effecting arrest of the accused persons in the aforesaid FIR No.67 but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is appearing through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the respondents – State and submits that a direction be issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa to dispose the matter in a legal manner.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take action against the accused persons for effecting their arrest and to ensure that no undue pressure is exhorted on the petitioner to compromise the matter, if the petitioner is not willing and also decide the representation (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
