Notice of motion to the official respondents-State.

Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. Copy of paper book be supplied during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who is an accused in the main case titled as 'Global Micronics India versus Saroj' in the complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act had appeared before the concerned Court in the main case on 14.08.2020 and had been released on bail.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the two sides and on perusal of the records, since, the petitioner had appeared in the main case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, on

account of which, she was declared an accused proclaimed offender, which led to registration of the present case under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code and it would sub-serve no purpose by sending the petitioner behind the bars in the present case. Her appearance before the Court concerned would suffice the purpose.

Keeping in view the situation of COVID-19 pandemic, this Court deems it imperative to allow the present petition. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer/Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and on she doing so, she shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). The petitioner shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that she shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, she will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
