Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to decide his stay application dated 22.07.2020 along with revision petition No.47 of 2020, titled as 'Shahabuden vs. RCS and others (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is Chairman of the Society. Respondent No.7-Ashruddin is working as salesmen in respondent No.6-society and has embezzled the funds of the said society. The bank wrote a letter to the society to provide the information regarding record of Ashruddin. Thereafter, the society wrote a letter to respondent No.7 to handover the record and the charge of the post. A complaint was received from the Sarpanch of village to the effect that respondent No.7 took bribe from the members and committed fraud with the society. Pursuant to the said complaint, respondent No.7 was suspended vide order dated 15.11.2016. However, respondent No.5-Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Palwal, passed the impugned order dated 13.06.2017 (Annexure P-1), whereby suspension of respondent No.7 was

with an application for stay, which has not been decided so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Deipa Singh, Addl. A.G.,
Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5.

This petition, at this stage, is disposed of by giving direction to the official respondents to decide the application for stay/revision/appeal expeditiously within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Till the disposal of the application for stay, operation of the impugned order dated 13.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) shall remain stayed.
