Both the petitioners have retired from the General Reserve Engineering Force (GREF) under the Border Road Organisation functioning under the Union of India. Petitioner No.1-Shri Madan Mohan retired as Charge Mechanic and petitioner No.2-Shri Sham Sunder retired as Superintendent Electronic and Mechanical, Grade-II.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that there were anomalies in the pensionary benefits of the employees of the GREF, whereupon a policy dated 17.01.2017 was initiated by the respondents to remove the anomalies and grant of higher pay scale w.e.f. 01.01.2006. But, even then, due benefit was not given to the petitioners and their pensions were fixed lower than what was due to them. Thereafter, petitioners made a representation dated 11.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) for correction of the anomalies in their pensions. Consequently, respondent No.2 wrote a letter dated 27.01.2020 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3 to revise their pension, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Union of India.

This petition, at this stage, is disposed of by giving direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to look into the representation dated 11.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) and pass appropriate/speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Compliance report thereof be sent to this Court.
