Sanjay Kumar, J.

The petitioner is an employee of Wallace Pharmaceuticals Private Limited, the 2nd and 3rd respondents herein. He was transferred by the said company from Patiala in the State of Punjab to Jaunpur in the State of Uttar Pradesh, on 13.07.2020. Alleging commission of an unfair labour practice, the petitioner moved an application (Annexure P-10) before the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Patiala. His grievance, presently, is that the said authority is not taking appropriate action thereon.

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, appearing for the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Patiala, the 1st respondent herein, would inform this Court that notice was ordered to the

employer-company by the 1st respondent and the matter was adjourned to

enable its counsel to file a reply. He would further state that the matter is coming up before the 1st respondent on 14.09.2020.

As the 1st respondent is seized of the application filed by the petitioner and it is for him to consider the same on its own merits and in accordance with law, no cause is made out for this Court to entertain the present writ petition for further adjudication.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Patiala, the 1st respondent herein, to pass appropriate orders on the petitioner's application (Annexure P-10) expeditiously and in any event, not later than three weeks from the date of receipt of the reply of the employer-company.

Be it noted that this Court has not gone into the merits of the matter and no orders have been passed against the employer-company, warranting that it should be put on notice or be afforded an opportunity of hearing.
