LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this contempt petition alleging violation of order dated 23.07.2020 passed in CWP-10466-2020 (Annexure P-1) with the averments that he has not been allowed to resume his duties pursuant to passing of the said order.

Learned counsel for the respondents, to whom an advance copy of the petition has been supplied, informs that the petitioner stood relieved of the charge of his duties on 13.07.2020. However, subsequent to passing of order dated 23.07.2020, the petitioner has joined at his post on 07.08.2020.

In so far as the argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioner that his salary for the month of May, June and July has not been released, Ms. Deepali Puri, Advocate, informs that the petitioner was under suspension from 08.05.2020 till 04.07.2020 and the requisite subsistence allowance stands released to him. Further, the application for leave, from 13.07.2020 to 07.08.2020, submitted by the petitioner, shall be decided within one week from today and necessary action taken.

In this view of the matter, no orders are called for at this stage.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
