The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to extend the benefit of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.4090 of 2020 titled as 'Subhash Chander vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 03.4.2013 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he had submitted a legal notice dated 29.7.2019 (Annexure P-4) upon the respondents but neither the legal notice has been decided nor the relief has been granted to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Simran Kaur Randhawa, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

The prayer has been made by learned counsel for the petitioner is for grant of extending the benefit of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.4090 of 2020 titled as 'Subhash Chander vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 03.4.2013 (Annexure P-1). This petition can be disposed of at this stage with a direction to the respondents to dispose of the legal notice, which was served upon by the petitioner vide Annexure P-4.

It is, therefore, directed that the respondents would decide the legal notice (Annexure P-4) and while deciding the legal notice, the respondents would also consider the judgment passed by this Court, annexed with this petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2.

Let legal notice be decided in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from today by passing a speaking order.
