Present application has been filed for placing on record certain documents as Annexures A-1 (colly) and A-2.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is partly allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Copy of discharge summary (A-1 (colly) is ordered to be taken on record, whereas, prayer for placing on record photographs (A-2) is rejected. Registry to tag the accepted documents at appropriate place.

Main case

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.143 dated 23.03.2020, under Sections 120-B, 147, 148, 323, 379-B, 427, 452, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Sections 325, 307 of IPC added later on), registered at Police

Station NIT Faridabad, District Faridabad.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the learned trial Court for seeking regular bail.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

It is clarified that in case, application for regular bail is moved by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided, within a period of four days thereafter, in accordance with law.
