Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.64 dated 18.05.2016 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. They apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 11.08.2020 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioners submitted themselves before the Police and joined the investigation. According to her, the petitioners cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Balraj does not dispute this fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation. He further states that they are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 11.08.2020 is made absolute.
