Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No. 2 to 4 to conduct investigation on the representations (Annexure P-2 to P-5) through some independent agency or by some high ranked police authority and to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members.

Reply by way of affidavit of Jashandeep Singh Gill, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana, has been filed by the learned State Counsel in Court today. The same is taken on record.

As per the reply, various inquiries on the complaints of the petitioners have been conducted by the then ACP(Rural-Gill) and the allegations were found to be false. Mela Singh, father of the petitioner No. 2, has left the house on 13.06.2015 by saying that he is going to Moga for some work and in this regard petitioner No. 2 had also got lodged a missing report.

On the basis of the information of petitioner No. 2 about missing of his father, a notice under Rule 27.79(1) of Punjab Police Rules was issued by the SHO, Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana, vide DDR No. 11 dated 17.07.2015. As per the status report, missing person has not been found till today.

Mela Singh, husband of the petitioner No. 1 and father of petitioner No. 2, entered into an agreement to sell dated 30.05.2015 with respondent No. 11 and entire payment was made, respondent No. 11 has constructed house on the said plot, where he is residing and respondent No. 5 is a marginal witness and now petitioners started levelling false allegations against respondents which were found to be false, by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present petitioner.
