The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Robin Singh @ Robin Parmar, stated to be aged 28 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 & 2 to transfer the investigation of the case FIR No.74 dated 29.05.2020 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 302/34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Records of the case show that on 11.08.2020, notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, by making reference to Para 3 of the petition, submits that in view of the relation of Kanwaljit Singh and ASI

Jasbir Singh (respondents No.5 & 6 in CRM-M-14806-2020) with the complainant/respondent No.6, the investigation of the case be transferred to any other district.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh (PPS), Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In Para 3 of the preliminary submissions of the reply, it has been *inter alia* stated that the private respondents (who are stated to be police officials related to the complainant) one of them posted in same district but not posted with the Police Station Amloh and second one is not working as a Gunman of any Member Parliament.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances as noticed above, this Court deems it appropriate to **dispose of** the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to himself examine the matter or depute any Competent Officer to examine the issue raised in the present petition and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

Ordered accordingly.
