In the present writ petition, the petitioners are alleging the intentional and wilful disobedience of the order passed by this Court dated 18.12.2019 (Annexure P-1) in CWP No.36796 of 2019 titled as Surjit Singh and others Vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondent has not decided the legal notice dated 19.08.2019 within the time frame allowed by this Court, making the respondent liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

Mr. Anupam Singla, Advocate, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in case the required order, as directed by this Court has not been passed already, the same will be passed within a period of next two weeks positively and in

case, the petitioners are found entitled for any relief, the same will also be released within a period of two weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of the learned counsel for the respondent, the petitioner does not wish to press this petition any further.

Disposed of having been not pressed.

In case, the undertaking recorded on behalf of the respondent is violated, serious view will be taken.
