The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel has filed the copy of joint statement made by the petitioners before the police, wherein the petitioners have stated that there is no apprehension to their life and liberty and they are living happily. The copy of said statement is taken on record.

In view of the above statement made by the petitioners, this Court finds that nothing survives in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed as infructuous.
