GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Bahadur Singh, stated to be aged 47 years, has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* with a prayer for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Sitta, Asst. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, based on the pleadings, submits that brother of the petitioner i.e. respondent no.6, is having relations with respondent No.5. Learned counsel then submits that for the same/similar grievance, the petitioner had submitted a complaint dated

25.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar (respondent no.2), followed by another complaint dated 04.07.2020 (Annexure P-2), which was submitted to the SSP, Roop Nagar.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned with representation dated 25.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) with regard to his alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar (respondent No.2), within three months from today, expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
