The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.341 dated 19.09.2016, under Section 323, 377, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 34, Chandigarh on the basis of compromise dated 17.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) arrived at, between the parties.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant disputes the factum of the compromise having been arrived at between the parties.

Learned State counsel submits that the trial is likely to conclude in the near future as all the prosecution witnesses stand examined.

In these circumstances, this court is not inclined to invoke its inherent powers envisaged under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition stands dismissed.
