Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the FIR No.4 dated 04.01.2013 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 12.12.2019 passed by this Court, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the parties were directed to appear on 14.01.2020.

A report dated 22.01.2020 has been received from the Mediator to the effect that the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable

settlement and a settlement/agreement dated 22.01.2020 has been reduced into writing.

Considering the fact that it being a matrimonial dispute and the matter has been compromised between the parties vide settlement/agreement dated 22.01.2020 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, this Court finds that the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, the settlement/agreement dated 22.01.2020 be made part of the record and the parties shall adhere to the terms and conditions of the settlement/agreement in its letter and spirit.
