1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for the issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.5 on the basis of representation Annexure P/4 dated 29.05.2020 (wrongly mentioned as Annexure P/3), and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent No.5 and his henchmen.
3. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/4 dated 29.05.2020 and take action in respect thereto, in accordance with law.
4. Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.
5. Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

6. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/4 dated 29.05.2020, in accordance with law, as also to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent No.5 etc and take such action in respect thereto as may be warranted, in the facts and circumstances of the case as expeditiously as possible.

7. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
