GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Gurdev Kaur and Surjit Kaur, stated to be aged 80 & 53 years respectively, have jointly filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* with a prayer for directing respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members from the hands of respondents No.5 & 6 and further directing respondents No.3 & 4 not to harass them by calling in the police station time and again.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Sitta, Asst. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, based on the pleadings,

submits that in fact, the petitioners were aggrieved of alleged illegalities committed by respondent No.5 and therefore they had approached the police authorities. However, there is further grievance also, for which, they have submitted a representation dated 12.06.2020 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (respondent no.2).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with representation (Annexure P-3) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (respondent no.2), within three months from today, expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (respondent no.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
