Petitioner-Inderdeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to carry the investigation in case FIR No.214 dated 21.12.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana and for taking action against the accused persons.

Pursuant to the notice of motion issued on 23.12.2016, a reply by way of affidavit of Sachin Gupta, IPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Ludhiana on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 was filed, wherein it was mentioned that the investigation is pending and final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. would be filed upon completion of the same.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh has apprised the Court that the challan against accused Akhtiar Singh

stands filed on 02.04.2018 before the Court of competent jurisdiction and

the investigation in respect of co-accused Rajdeep Kaur, who was arrested on 05.07.2018 is also complete and the final report is likely to be filed within four weeks.

In view of above, the petition is rendered infructuous and disposed off as such.
