1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for transfer of investigation of case FIR No.50 dated 06.05.2020, registered under Sections 302, 307, 323, 324, 326, 341, 188, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC and Section 51 and 54 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, at Police Station Pasyana, District Patiala, to the Central Bureau of Investigation or Crime Branch, Chandigarh or any other independent agency, to ensure fair and impartial investigation.

Learned counsel states that it has come to his notice today itself that challan has been filed and name of some of the accused in the FIR do not find mention as accused in the challan and that in the circumstances, he be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to appropriate remedy before the learned trial Court in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
