GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner – Vijay Kumar stated to be aged 34 years has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents to consider the candidature of the petitioner for the post of Head Teacher on the basis of merit secured by him against the advertisement No.CHT/HT (Annexure P-12), with a further prayer to direct the respondents to select and appoint him on the post of Head Teacher in the category of SC (R&O) along with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that for the same/similar grievances as made in the present writ petition, the petitioner has also got served a legal notice dated 08.12.2019 (Annexure P-19) upon the respondents No.1 and 2, but till date no action has been taken. Learned counsel, however, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the direction is issued to decide the legal notice dated 08.12.2019 (Annexure P-19).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents-Competent Authority, to consider the legal notice dated 08.12.2019 (Annexure P-19) and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
