VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has been arrayed as an accused in the case bearing FIR No. 11 dated 14.1.2013 under Section 307, 323, 324, 326, 458, 459, 460, 427, 201, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala. His co-accused faced trial and were acquitted with regard to the offences under Sections 450, 307, 326, 201 read with Section 149 IPC. However, the co-accused namely Satnam Singh, Gurwinder Singh and Avtar Singh were convicted for the offences under Sections 148, 452, 324 read with Section 149 IPC and were released on probation of good conduct vide judgment dated 28.1.2016 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Patiala.

On May 23, 2019 following order was passed:-

Application is for placing on record amended Memo of Parties as Annexure A-1.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Accompanied amended

Memo of Parties is taken on record as Annexure A-1.

Registry to tag the same at the appropriate place.

MAIN CASE

Contentends that petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before learned trial Court and to pay the reasonable costs.

Notice of motion for 09.08.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner would be at liberty to join the proceedings before learned trial Court and be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing subject to payment of costs of ₹ 1,00,000/- (One Lakh) to be deposited with the Headmaster of Govt. School i.e. GPS Gajipur, UDISE Code 3170704801, Rajpura, District Patiala and the same shall be utilized for the construction of Toilet for girl students as well as for purchasing the Text-Books and Stationery Items for the deserving students.”

It has been stated that in terms of the order, the petitioner has already put appearance before the learned trial Court. The State counsel has also acknowledged the fact that a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- has already been deposited in the concerned School and status report by way of affidavit of Akashdeep Singh Aulakh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Rajpura, District Patiala is already on record.

In these set of circumstances, order dated 23.5.2019 vide which the interim bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute. However, it is directed that he shall furnish fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Court within a reasonable time to be provided by it.
