The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 303 dated 08.11.2019 under Sections 306, 34, 201 IPC and later on added Section 304-B, IPC registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from her.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Narinder Kumar, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for any custodial interrogation. At this stage, Mr. Munish Khangowal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant. He opposes the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

However, since the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 13.08.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
