The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.82 dated 25.02.2020 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC at Police Station Islamabad District, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that husband of the petitioner was arrested and thereafter he was granted regular bail vide order dated 07.08.2020 passed in CRM-M No.19736 of 2020. Petitioner is mother-in-law of the

deceased. Daughter of the petitioner is in custody.

Learned counsel further submitted that in compliance of the order 11.08.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jitender Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 11.08.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
