Petitioner Nirmal Singh and 12 others working against non-teaching posts in Government Schools in the State of Punjab, by way of filing the instant civil writ petition, seek issuance of a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for regularization of their services w.e.f. 01.04.2018, the date from which the services of members of teaching faculty appointed on the same terms and conditions had been regularized, vide notification dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P7).

The petitioners are said to have submitted representations (Annexures P8 and P11) to the respondents before filing of the present writ petition without evoking any response.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners and going through

the record, since the respondents are not shown to have passed any order on the representations (Annexures P8 and P11) submitted by the petitioners before filing of the instant writ petition, in the interest of justice and to avoid unnecessary litigation between the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of, directing the respondents to consider the representations (Annexures P8 and P11) submitted by the petitioners and necessary action, if any, be taken within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
