1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to decide and take action on the complaint (Annexure P-5) dated 31.01.2020, as also complaint (Annexure P-6) dated 04.07.2020 against respondent Nos.5, 6 and 9 for committing fraud and cheating upon the petitioner in connivance with respondent Nos.8 and 9. Prayer is also for directions to respondent No.2 to get proper investigation done in the case as per law against respondent Nos.5, 6 and 9 from an officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police, Hisar etc.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Anant Kataria, learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from District Attorney (Public Prosecutor), Hisar, states that the complaint was enquired into but found devoid of merit, accordingly the same was ordered to be filed.

5. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition, with liberty to take recourse to appropriate remedy before the court below in accordance with law.

4. The same is not opposed to by learned DAG, Haryana.

5. In the light of the position noted above, the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty as prayed for.
