Through this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners have prayed for quashing of FIR No.158 dated 27.11.2016 under Sections 324, 452, 323, 326 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1) and the proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 29.04.2019 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the parties.

Vide order dated 14.05.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for recording of their statements and report was sought regarding compromise.

Pursuant to said order, a report dated 31.05.2019 has been submitted by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, wherein it is stated that complainant Paramjit Singh s/o Gajjan Singh had appeared before the Court on 28.05.2019 and stated that he does not want to record his statement with regard to compromise in the subject FIR and the

petitioners/accused also did not turn up for recording their statements.

In view of above, it is evident that the compromise is not supported by the parties, therefore, the petition fails and is dismissed.
