ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL)

By this order, CRM-M-22562-2020 and CRM-M-16880-2020,
shall stand disposed of.

One application is filed by the deceased's wife Manjit Kaur for
grant of regular bail, whereas other application has been filed by Sant Ram
and Guljari Devi, maternal uncle and aunt for grant of pre-arrest bail.

It may be noted here that initially a case under Section 302 IPC,
was registered on the allegations that Manjit Kaur with the help her
relatives, had forcibly administered some poisonous substance to Late Sh.

Karamjeet (Manjit Kaur's husband). During investigation, the statement of the deceased's daughter was recorded, by the Station House Officer, in which she has stated that her father consumed some poisonous substance on his own. Thus, offence under Section 306 IPC was added.

On careful reading of the statement of the child, it is apparent that it was the petitioner and her relatives, who took the deceased to hospital after he had consumed poisonous substance.

The petitioner-Manjit Kaur is in custody since 06.06.2020.

On completion of the investigation, the police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. (challan) has already been submitted in the court.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner-Manjit Kaur is in custody since 06.06.2020 and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner-Manjit Kaur is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Whereas interim bail granted to Sant Parkash and Guljari Devi on 16.07.2020 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the petitions are allowed with the aforesaid directions.
