1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the official respondents to take appropriate legal action on representations (Annexures P-3 & P-4) dated 02.06.02020 and 20.07.2020 respectively and for registration of case against respondent No.5 for misappropriating Rs.43,70,182/-.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it has come to the notice of the petitioner that the respondents have recommended the closure of the case but the petitioner has submitted comprehensive representation (Annexure P-4) dated 20.07.2020 and the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-4) dated 20.07.2020 before taking a final decision, in the matter.

4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Gurdial Singh, states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.3 to consider and take into account the representation (Annexure P-4) dated 20.07.2020, while taking a decision on the enquiry report viz. a viz. the complaint made by the petitioner.

6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
