1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for the issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.61 dated 02.09.2019, registered U/s 304-A IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran, by entrusting the same to a SIT.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, states that investigation of the case already stands marked to the Superintendent of Police (Headquarters), Tarn Taran for investigation in a fair and impartial manner.
5. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. In the light of the position as noted above, the petition is disposed of by directing official respondents to conclude the investigation

which is being conducted in case FIR No.61 dated 02.09.2019, registered under Section 304-A of IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran, in accordance with law, expeditiously and thereafter to take such further action in the matter as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case.
