The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to protect their life and liberty and their family members at the hands of respondents No.3 to 7 and to take action against private respondents against whom the FIR No.210 dated 21.11.2014 under Sections 452, 354, 323, 447, 511, 427, 148 and 149 IPC has been registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Kanwal Pal Singh, PPS, DSP, Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural) has already been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

As per the said reply, an inquiry was conducted in the case and as per the inquiry report, the petitioner has concocted a false story and levelled false allegations and there is no truth in the allegations.

Learned State counsel has informed this Court that Challan in the case has been presented and charge has been framed and the case is pending before the trial Court.

In view of the above reply and the statement of learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
