Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

In pursuance to the order dated 07.09.2020 passed by this Court, learned State counsel has forwarded a medical status report of the petitioner and the same is taken on record.

As per certificate given by the Medical Officer, Incharge, Jail Hospital, Faridkot, petitioner is a known case of HIV and HCV reactive. He is being afforded treatment for both HIV and HCV at Jail Hospital, Faridkot. It has further been opined that the petitioner is medically stable.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery in the present case is of 4500 intoxicant tablets containing the salt of Tramadol hydrochloride (1834 grams).

The recovery is heavy in nature as also commercial.

In view of the above, prayer of the petitioner seeking regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.297, dated 05.12.2019, under Section 22 of

the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar  
Sahib does not warrant acceptance.

Petition is dismissed.
