All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

On 18.08.2020, the following order had been passed:-

“All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a violation of Sections 50 and 57 of the NDPS Act (even though the recovery of 273 grams of heroin is stated to have been made from his car), on secret information.

However, learned State counsel submits that there are 19 other FIRs registered against the petitioner, which learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to verify.

Adjourned to 28.10.2020, with learned State counsel to also file an affidavit of a gazetted officer giving therein the detail of the status of all cases registered against the petitioner.

Obviously, no comment on the merits of the case has been made so far, even as regards this application/petition seeking bail, by this court..”

Today learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not wish to pursue this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
