Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 98 dated 06.04.2019 registered under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Vide order dated 10.06.2019, the petitioner was granted interim bail, subject to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner and deposited Rs. 2 lakhs with the Registry of this Court in terms of the order dated 14.05.2019 and has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rameshwar, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation but remaining amount is yet to be recovered from him.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant states that the petitioner has admitted that he has taken money to get the jobs to one son and one daughter of two complainants.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has deposited Rs. 2 lakhs in compliance of order dated 14.05.2019, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
