Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.99 dated 29.05.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Ghuman, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case for the reason that there is a matrimonial dispute between the parties; he relies on photographs to contend that at 3.13 p.m. the complainant party had no injuries on them while they alleged in the FIR that they were inflicted the injuries at 1 p.m.; thus, the injuries on the complainant party are self-inflicted; all the alleged injuries except one are simple in nature; the grievous injury is on the non-vital part of the body and that under the interim orders passed by this Court

the petitioner has not only joined the investigation he has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh submits that under the interim orders passed by this Court the petitioner has not only joined the investigation he has also fully co-operated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

Keeping in view the totality of the above noticed facts, especially the statement made by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order of this Court dated 13.08.2020, granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
