This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 55 dated 04.07.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 379-B, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

On 13.08.2020 while issuing notice of motion the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Counsel at the very outset makes a statement that he is not pressing the instant petition qua petitioner no.1 namely Jagroop Singh son of Sukhdev Singh.

Accordingly, the present petition qua petitioner no.1 Jagroop Singh stands dismissed.

In so far as petitioner no.2 Harjinder Kaur is concerned, counsel submits that the only attribution is of having raised a Lalkara.

Notice of motion, returnable for 5.10.2020. In the meanwhile, petitioner no.2 is directed to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner no.2 Harjinder Kaur shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner no.2 shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and she shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State Counsel, upon instructions from ASI Pritam Singh, informs the Court that the petitioners have since joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, petition is allowed. Order dated 13.08.2020 passed by this Court is made absolute.
