The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.102 dated 03.07.2020, registered under Sections 304-B, 149 IPC at
Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The operative part of the order dated 13.08.2020, vide
which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is
reproduced as under:-

*“...Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that
petitioner is married sister-in-law of Amandeep Kaur, who
committed suicide on 02.07.2020. Marriage of the
deceased was solemnized with Bajrang Bansal (brother of
the petitioner) on 29.03.2020, whereas marriage of the
present petitioner was solemnized in the year 2010.*

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance
to the order dated 13.08.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the

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Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State assisted by counsel for the complainant and on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.08.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
