Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.102 dated 23.06.2016 registered under Section 307 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana.

Since the petitions are arising from same FIR, therefore, above mentioned petitions are being decided by this common order.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that the prosecution has discharged the onus by examining all the witnesses and the case is now fixed for 07.02.2020 for defence evidence.

It is evident that the trial is at the fag end and is likely to conclude in near future.
