1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.145, dated 28.06.2020, registered under Sections 3, 4 of the Punjab Prohibition of Cow Slaughter Act, 1955, Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Section 429 IPC, at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 14.08.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from *SI Paramjit Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 14.08.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Punjab, order dated 14.08.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
