In the present petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks directions to provide protection to the life and liberty.

It is the case of the petitioner that she was married with respondent No.4 and they do not have any child. She has left her matrimonial home and is living separately since 2014 and is in a relationship with a third person. Resultantly, she seeks protection from the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 7, who are her in-laws. It is submitted that representation dated 28.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted to respondent No.2 regarding this aspect.
