The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing DDR No. 13 dated 07.08.2017 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149, 323, 324 and 506 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 in FIR No. 122 dated 07.08.2017 under Sections 307, 506, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural.

On 14.08.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the

petitioners' party is the complainant in FIR No.122 dated 7.8.2017 under Sections 307, 506, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25/ 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar. Cross-version was recorded vide DDR No. 13 dated 7.8.2017 at the instance of complainant Palwinder Pal. In the cross-version, petitioner No.1 with alias name Suba is alleged to have given brick bat blows on the legs of complainant Palwinder Pal. Petitioner No.2 with alias name Bhala Mehra is alleged to have inflicted dang blow on the person of Palwinder Pal. According to the Medico Legal Report, Palwinder Pal received six injuries and all the injuries are declared to be simple in nature. No injury was found on the legs of Palwinder Pal. The alleged injury with dang is non specific in nature.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Sukhbir Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 17.8.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to their furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List again on 5.10.2020..”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shish Pal admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order

dated 14.08.2020 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
