The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to carry out necessary action so that an online E-Vahan portal entry for the vehicle bearing registration No. PAR-1, owned by the petitioner, be made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as required by law, the petitioner has already submitted self-declaration/affidavit (Annexure P-3) along with representation dated 24.06.2020 but online E-vahan portal entry of the vehicle has not been made so far, necessitating the petitioner to file the present writ petition.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Addl. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to take note of the contents of representation dated 24.06.2020 (Annexure P-5) and to act in accordance with law, preferably within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The authorities shall be well within their right to ask the petitioner any other document required by law while deciding the representation (Annexure P-5).
