Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.60 dated 19.06.2020 under Sections 326, 323, 324, 427, 447, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 13.08.2020: -

“... Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the petitioner is not attributed with injury No.7 on the person of Daljit Singh, or injury No.8 suffered by Didar Singh, which attracts the rigours of Section 306 IPC...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

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aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.08.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
