The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.91 dated 20.06.2020 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act (Act No.61 of 1985) at Police Station Dialpura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that 10 kgs. of poppy husk was recovered from the house of co-accused Jagjit Singh. Name of the petitioner was nominated by the co-accused Jagjit Singh in his disclosure statement along with Rajwinder Singh. Recovery has already been effected from Jagjit Singh which is non-commercial in nature.

Learned counsel further submitted that in compliance of the order dated 13.08.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Malkit Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.08.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
