JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR No. 10 dated 27.03.2019 registered under Sections 498-A and 323 IPC at Police Station Women, District Bathinda and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of a compromise dated 22.04.2019.

In brief, the facts are that on account of a dispute between the parties, an FIR was registered at Women Police Station, Bathinda which was subsequently compromised between the parties, pursuant to which, this petition for quashing was filed. The parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the genuineness of the compromise and accordingly, the statements were recorded.

However, it appears that the compromise has not been adhered to in letter and spirit. In terms of the compromise, respondent No. 3 and the petitioner herein were to reside together, respondent No. 3 being the sister

of the complainant. However, it appears that the complainant's sister-respondent No. 3 herein, has been thrown out of her matrimonial home and therefore, the compromise has not been given effect to.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the matter remains alive, the respondent-State shall proceed in accordance with law.
