Case taken up through video conferencing.

By way of filing the present writ petition, petitioner Rajveer and 29 others crave for grant of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents – State of Haryana through its Commissioner and Secretary, Director, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana, Municipal Corporation, NIT, Faridabad through Commissioner, Fire Brigade, Faridabad through Commissioner, Municipal Corporation NIT Faridabad and M/S ARC Security Solutions Pvt. Ltd. to take/adjust the petitioners on corporation muster role as per Part-II of the Outsourcing Policy dated 16.2.2009 and 6.4.2015 and further to comply with Govt. Order bearing memo

No.14/76/2018/4CI dated 6.9.2019 (Annexure P-II), directing the Commissioners of all Corporations in State of Haryana to take he employees, who have been working through outsourcing agency on muster role at parity with sweepers working in respondents – corporation and drivers in fire brigade. They have sought further relief of grant of minimum scale to them at par with regular employees in view of instructions dated 3.11.2017 (Annexure P-10) issued by State of Haryana along with consequent action and a direction to respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 16.6.2020 (Annexure P19) etc.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Rajiv Sidhu, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent – State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.6.2020(Annexure P-19) within a fixed time frame.

Learned State counsel submits that the respondents would do so as per the directions issued by this Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of such request of learned counsel for the petitioners and response given by the State counsel and further to avoid any unnecessary litigation between the parties, the present petition is disposed of directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.6.2020(Annexure P-19) in accordance with law, by way of a speaking order within a period of two months from today.

However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved even after passing of the order, they may seek their legal remedy including approaching this Court as per law.
