Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 30.10.2012 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, whereby the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed offenders.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 03.02.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioners have been admitted on interim bail by the trial Court. The petitioners have also furnished an undertaking before the trial Court that they shall face the trial in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, it being a matrimonial dispute between Pawanjit Kaur and petitioner No.1 Gurjot Singh and the petitioner No.1 having a decree of divorce from the Canadian Court, at this stage, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to expedite the trial.
