Main case

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.'), is for grant of pre-
arrest bail in FIR NO.28 dated 21.02.2020, registered under Section 306
read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. GRP, District
Jalandhar.

Heard.

This is the second anticipatory bail petition. The first one was

dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file afresh with better particulars.

The petitioner has changed his stance and the very nature of the petition which cannot be permitted.

Learned counsel for the complainant informs that the petitioner now has been declared a proclaimed person vide order dated 17.08.2020, passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.

In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to go into the merits of the petition, at this stage.
