Briefly, the FIR bearing No. 40 dated 11.04.2019 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Rahon, District SBS Nagar has been registered in pursuance of recovery of 69 injections of Buprenorphine.

It has been contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated and no other case has been registered against him.

On the contrary, it has been pointed out by the learned State counsel that the quantity of contraband recovered from the possession of the petitioner falls in the category of commercial quantity.

In the instant case, 69 injections of Buprenorphine each measuring 02 ml have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The quantity of contraband recovered from the possession of the petitioner falls in the category of commercial quantity. As such stringent provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act
