The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.33 dated 26.3.2019 registered under Sections 22, 29, 61, 85, 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

While praying for bail, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been enroped because the motorcycle belongs to the him, whereas, no recovery has been effected from him. Recovery was effected from one Manjinder Singh alias Manni, who had borrowed his motorcycle. Recovery in the present case is of 27 injections of Leegestic containing Buprenorphine salt. No other evidence has been pointed out to this Court except that the motorcycle belongs to the petitioner. The petitioner had no idea as to for which purpose the motorcycle was borrowed from him.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
